

## **Motion One**

### **PAY THE ALTERNATE DELEGATE'S EXPENSES TO ATTEND THE ANNUAL STATEWIDE MISSOURI A.A. CONVENTION**

#### **Background:**

At the 1994 Nov. Assembly, a motion (ML-27) was passed: "The Area Alternate Delegate will serve as the Liaison to the Missouri A.A. Convention."

In the capacity of Liaison, the Alternate Delegate is responsible for securing an AI-Anon Speaker; hosting the Speaker; finding volunteers to facilitate AI-Anon recovery meetings, and to act as readers during the introduction of the Speaker; and any other duties involved with our Sixth Tradition commitment to cooperate with Alcoholics Anonymous.

Research reveals that no motion has ever been proposed to reimbursement the Alternate Delegate's expenses involved in attending the Missouri A.A. Convention.

However, in May of 2015, the Assembly passed a motion (ML-67) stating that "The Missouri Area will reimburse the Missouri Area Literature Depot Coordinator's and the Missouri Area Alternate Literature Depot Coordinator's mileage, lodging and banquet expense to attend the annual Missouri A.A. Convention for the purpose of selling AI-Anon Conference Approved Literature. Lodging covered will total a two-night stay."

Therefore, in accordance with our Seventh Tradition, the following motion is proposed:

#### **MOTION ONE**

The Missouri Area will reimburse the Alternate Delegate for mileage, two nights lodging, registration, and banquet expenses to attend the annual Statewide Missouri A.A. Convention, where they will perform service as the AI-Anon Liaison.
